

Welcome to Camp Spicewood

Our enthusiastic staff this year includes 10 counselors, 2 swim teachers, 2 horseback-riding teachers, 2 art teachers, an activity leader and good ol' Mrs. Bird. Lauren Menefee will be the administrative assistant. We are looking forward to having the best summer camp ever!

Here are some camp survival tips:

1. **Records** – We must have all paperwork (registration form-top half, enrollment information and waiver of liability) completed and put on file at time of registration. When you arrive for camp, all you will need is your check ready – refer to your chart for unusual prices and schedules. No more snack !
2. **Labels** – Please label all your child's belongings and do not send toys, video games, etc. Your child needs only a bag or a backpack, swimsuit, towel, and a lunch.
3. **Sunblock** – Please apply before arriving. We will remind your child to use it later, but he/she should be able to apply it alone.
4. **Drinks** – We will sell both regular and diet carbonated drinks for \$1.00. Please send correct change each day or send a drink. Sorry that we cannot provide refrigeration; cold packs work great. This year we have cold water available at all times.
5. **Snacks** – This year, one snack will be provided free each day. Your child will have several choices including ice cream and other frozen treats. Candy will not be offered.
6. **Yell Practice** – At 9:05 each morning, when the whistle is blown, all campers and counselors will gather on the railroad ties for announcements and a few rousing spirit cheers. Then each group will disperse at 9:15 to begin their daily activities.
7. **Pick-up Time** – Follow the drive single file and please don't get out of your car unless you pull off to the left and park. We can load 4-5 cars at a time if the lead car will move up to the cones each time.
8. **Camp Out** – There will be an overnight camp out the last day of each session beginning at 7:30pm Friday night. Please have your child wear a swimsuit, bring a towel, a change of clothes, p.j.'s and bedding material. The camp out will end at 9:00am Saturday morning after breakfast. The cost is \$35.00 per child and is offered to children ages 5 or older.
9. **Extended Care** – The camp schedule is as follows:

7:30	Camp doors open.
7:30-9:00	Playground time.
3:15-4:15	Free pool time.
4:30	Snack time.
5:30	Pick-up time. (NO later!)
