

Welcome to Camp Spicewood

Our enthusiastic staff includes around 25 counselors: group counselors, swim teachers, horseback-riding teachers, art teachers, activity leaders, and camp directors. We are looking forward to a great summer!

Here are some camp survival tips:

1. **Records & Tuition** – We must have all paperwork (registration form-top half, enrollment form, Consent & liability, and **immunization record**) completed and on file at camper’s first day of camp. Registration fee (\$100) is due at time of registration. Tuition is due on the first day of each session, **we accept checks and cash only**.
2. **Labels** – Please label all your child’s belongings and do not send toys, video games, cell phones etc. Your child needs only a bag or a backpack, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, lunch, and a water bottle.
3. **Sunblock** – Please apply before arriving. Please provide sunscreen (spray is preferred, thank you). We will remind and help your child reapply sunscreen throughout the day.
4. **Lunch & Drinks** – Please pack a lunch and water bottle for your child. Sorry, we cannot provide refrigeration; cold packs work great. We will sell carbonated drinks, juice drinks, and sports drinks for \$1.00 during lunch. Please send correct change each day or send a drink. We have cold water available at all times.
5. **Snacks** – Spicewood will provide one snack per camper per day and an additional snack for each camper that stays for afternoon extended care. Your child will have a variety of several choices; including ice cream, frozen treats, goldfish, fruit snacks, chips, slushies, etc.....
6. **Yell Practice** – At 9:05 each morning, campers and counselors will gather at their designated tables, located around the playground (physically distanced from other groups), for announcements and a few cheers. Each group will be dismissed one at a time to begin their daily activities.
7. **Camper Drop-Off & Pick-Up** – Signs will be placed to direct parking for drop-off and pick-up. Camper drop-off and pick-up will be outdoors, by the parking lot, and outside of the camp playground. Camp Staff will be outside directing drop-off and pick-up.

Camper Drop-Off: Staff will perform camper’s daily health screening before checking camper into camp. Campers will then be escorted into camp by staff. Please have enrollment form, consent and liability, the latest copy of immunization record, and tuition payment (Spicewood accepts checks and cash only) ready on the first day check-in, thank you.

Camper Pick-Up: Campers will be escorted by staff to their parents or authorized person on camper’s pick-up list.
