Welcome to Camp Spicewood

Our enthusiastic staff includes around 25 counselors: group counselors, lifeguards & swim instructors, horseback-riding instructors, art teachers, activity leaders, and camp directors. We are looking forward to a great summer!

Here are some camp survival tips:

- 1. Records & Tuition Registration fee (\$150 per child) and top half of the registration form is due at registration, \$50 is non-refundable and \$100 will be applied towards the tuition of your last registered session. Tuition is due on the first day of each session, we accept cash or checks only! If you cancel, Spicewood will not bill for tuition, however, none of the registration fee will be refunded. We must have all paperwork (enrollment form, consent & liability, and current immunization record) completed and on file for the camper's first day of camp.
- 2. <u>Labels</u> Please label all your child's belongings and do not send toys, video games, cell phones etc. Your child needs only a backpack, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, lunch, and a water bottle.
- 3. <u>Sunblock</u> Please apply before arriving and provide sunscreen (spray is preferred, thank you). We will remind and help your child reapply sunscreen throughout the day.
- 4. <u>Lunch & Drinks</u> Please pack a lunch and water bottle for your child. Sorry, we cannot provide refrigeration; cold packs work great. We will sell carbonated drinks, juice drinks, and sports drinks for \$1.00 during lunch. Please send correct change each day <u>or</u> send a drink. We have cold water available at all times.
- 5. <u>Snacks</u> Spicewood will provide one snack per camper per day and an additional snack for each camper that stays for afternoon extended care. Your child will have a variety of choices; including ice cream, frozen treats, goldfish, fruit snacks, chips, slushies, etc......
- **Yell Practice** At 9:05 each morning, campers and counselors will gather at their designated tables, located around the playground, for announcements and a few cheers. Each group will be dismissed one at a time to begin their daily activities.
- 7. Camper Drop Off & Pick Up Camper drop off and pick up will be outside on the playground at designated group tables with their counselors. Camp Staff will assist with drop off and pick up. Parents/Guardians are required to check their children in and out of camp with their child's counselor or camp staff.
- **8.** <u>Discipline & Guidance</u> -It is Spicewood's goal to provide a healthy, safe, and fun camp experience for every child! Our camp staff will re-direct aggressive or disobedient behavior in a positive way, should these methods fail, parents will be called to discuss the behavior, so we can work together. Spicewood Country Camp reserves the right to disenroll a child, if it is in the best interest of the child or other campers at Spicewood.
- 9. <u>First Day Tips</u> Please have enrollment form, consent and liability, copy of current immunization record, and tuition payment (Spicewood accepts checks and cash only) ready on the first day check-in.
